TERM 3 CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

ENGLISH

This term, our Prep students will explore both narrative and informative texts through a fun, real-life learning experience - a Teddy Bears Picnic!

Students will compare the features of different text types before planning and participating in their very own picnic with their favourite teddy.

After the event, students will become authors as they recount their EPIC day for an audience. They will learn to sequence events, write clear sentences, include descriptive language, and enhance their writing with colourful illustrations.

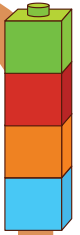


MATHEMATICS

This term, students will explore early mathematical concepts through the exciting context of a Teddy Bears' Picnic.

They will build confidence with counting, addition, subtraction, equal sharing, repeating patterns, and describing the position of objects using mathematical language.

Through hands-on investigations, games, and real-life problem-solving, students will apply their learning in meaningful ways.



SCIENCE

Students will investigate how weather influences everyday lives and the world around us. They will explore different types of weather, observe changes in temperature, clouds, wind and rainfall, and discover how weather impacts our choices.

Through hands-on investigations and observations, students will develop their scientific understanding before applying their learning by creating and presenting their own weather report.



HASS

This term, students will explore the special places in their school and community, learning why they are important to different people.

They will create simple maps, investigate the significance of Country/Place for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples, and discover ways to care for the places around them through hands-on inquiry and exploration.



DRAMA

Students are investigating songs and actions about Teddy Bears to learn about different experiences, ideas and feelings. They are learning the elements of drama through songs and actions.

MUSIC

This term, students will explore the elements of music through listening, singing, composing and performing. Using weather-themed songs and activities, they will develop rhythm, pitch and music literacy while building confidence in expressing their ideas through music.



HPE

Students develop fundamental movement skills through athletics, including running, jumping, throwing and relay activities, while building confidence, balance and coordination. They will also explore what it means to belong, identify the groups they are part of, and learn how to include and support others.
